Re: Official Information Act Request – Covert Surveillance of Staff

Kia ora

Thanks you for your request for information under the Official Information Act 1982.

The Hauora Tairāwhiti response is as follows:

1. Any policy regarding the covert surveillance of staff.

There is no specific policy. Information Security policy has a section regarding Monitoring System access and use which enables review and monitoring at management's discretion. For example HR systems and pin door entries.

2. The number of times there have been applications for surveillance of staff.

3. The number of times there have been approvals for surveillance of staff.

4. The circumstances in which any surveillance of staff would be permissible.

This would be on a case by case basis where all other avenues have been exhausted and the nature of the situation extenuating warranting surveillance.
