[Data for the 2020 year is unknown] If so, what has caused the DHB to reduce the number of age residential care beds available? N/A Have you had to reduce the number of general hospital beds available since March 2020? No If so, what has caused the DHB to reduce the number of general beds available? N/A How many general hospital beds were available in your catchment area in March 2020, and how many general hospital beds are available now? 80 and the same number now.
