Re: Official Information Act Request – Staff assaults on patients

Kia ora [REDACTED],

Thank you for your request for information under the Official Information Act 1982.

You asked:

“Can ministry of health please email me aggravated staff investigations of assaults on patients ie staff fired, investigated and resigning before being fired / criminal charges being laid / withdrawn by victim?”

The Hauora Tairāwhiti response is as follows:

Hauora Tairāwhiti does not hold the information you have requested at the required level to answer your request nor is it held in an easily retrievable format. To provide you with the requested information would require a substantial amount of time and resource. We are therefore declining your request pursuant to section 18(f) of the Official Information Act i.e. “.... the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research”.
