Re: Official Information Act Request – Precocious Puberty

Kia ora

Thank you for your request for information under the Official Information Act 1982.

You asked:

- 1. How many children were referred for precocious puberty in each calendar year from 2006 until the most recent available year (presumably 2021)?
- 2. How many children were being treated (i.e. total ongoing treatments) for precocious puberty in each calendar year from 2006 until the most recent available year?

The Hauora Tairāwhiti response to your request is as follows:

Hauora Tairāwhiti does not code referrals nor outpatient review and treatment outcome at the level of detail requested in any retrievable fashion; the only such information that may be recorded being that held in individual clinical case notes and patient records. We therefore decline to provide additional information that may or may not be held if we undertook manual research of each of individual patients' case notes under Section 18 (f) of the Official Information Act i.e. "... that the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research."
