I am responding on behalf of Hauora Tairāwhiti (Tairāwhiti DHB) to your OIA Request of 26 March 2019.

Our response to your request:

In total, how many DHB employees have been progressed under the Career and Salary Progression (CASP) Framework of the successive Allied, Public Health & Technical Multi Employer Collective Agreements between the Public Service Association and District Health Boards since CASP was first introduced?

In total we are able to identify that there are 26 employees who are on step 7 or greater who are not identified as being in designated positions. Of these 6 are clearly identified as having progressed there under CASP.
