Re: Official Information Act

I am responding on behalf of Hauora Tairāwhiti (Tairāwhiti DHB) to your OIA Request of 26 January 2019 regarding injury and death related to heatstroke.

You asked our DHB:

Recorded cases of organ failure; brain damage; and death related to heat-stroke and/or sun-stroke by the DHB in the calendar years (January 1 to December 31) in 2014, 15, 16, 17 and 2018, broken down by year and type of injury.

Our response:

We had one case of "acute renal failure due to heatstroke and sunstroke" in January 2018. No other cases of "organ failure, brain damage or death" for the period specified.
