I am responding on behalf of Hauora Tairāwhiti (Tairāwhiti DHB) to your OIA Request of 18 February 2019 regarding prescribed antidepressants.

Request:

I would like a copy of any and all information totalling the number of patients prescribed antidepressants in 2018 as inpatients and in the community (scope clarified with the requester and confirmed—RL, 18.2.2019). Please include the age and gender of the patient(s).

Your OIA was partially transferred to TAS on 19 February as they hold information for community pharmacy dispensed anti-depressant medication. Our DHB was asked to provide our individual held data for the DHB pharmacy prescribed and dispensed anti-depressant medication.

Our response:

Hauora Tairāwhiti's Pharmacy is unable to provide the data by individual patient as we keep most of our drugs on the wards as imprest stock and don't individually dispense.

Antidepressants are kept as imprest stock on the wards that most frequently use them, e.g. mental health.

We dispense to individual patients to those wards who use them occasionally, therefore the data will be incomplete and missing on the majority of patients.
